Joyner, for the Senior Club Champion.

In the era (1924/25 to 1948/49), the All Rounder Award was recognised as greater in honor than the Grade Batting, Bowling or Fielding Award. There are no records of this award from 1949/50 until 1963/64, however it has also been suggested by members from this era that it in their collective recall, it was not awarded at all.
