E.G. (Ted) Beaumont



The great inter war all rounder, who debuted in 1926/27, then crossed to Boronia while the club was in recess from 1928/29 until 1932/33. He returned in 1933/34 to dominate our first Premiership winning season. With a career disrupted by the recess and ending at World War 2 he won 1st XI Batting, Bowling & All Rounder awards & scored 1,323 1st XI runs – 1 x 100 (the only one between 1914/15 & 1953/54), 7 x 50's & also scored a 100 for the MDCA on the MCG. He took over 200 wickets – 16 x 5 W/I, 2 x 7 W/I, 1 x 10 W/M with a best of 7/23 and 4 times >40 wickets in a season in an era when he was the dominant player of the Club and one of the stars of the district.
