
I.J.B. (lan) Ewart

Served in an administration capacity for over 15 years as President, Vice Pres & Treasurer. Won 11 Club Batting Averages (8 in the 1st XI), a Bowling Average and is an 8 time Premiership player from 22 Finals matches.
