

H. (Henry 'Harry') Monk



One of the most influential administrators in club history. President for over 14 years from 1899 to the commencement of WW 1 (Unconfirmed records suggest he may have actually held office for 22 successive years from 1895 until after WW1!) Affiliated the Club in competition cricket with the Reporter DCA in 1913/14 for the first time, after being the driving force behind the establishment of the Recreation Reserve in 1912. Helped re-establish both the Cricket and Football clubs post War, and served as a Committee Member of both for over 30 years. Stepped away from club duties in 1922.
