F.N. (Fred) Stevens



Commenced playing in 1884, the great pre WW1 bowler whose record, though incomplete, still has him at the top of the Club's best ever bowlers with over 400 wickets. He took an unusual career best of 11/19 in an Innings when 12 batted by Captain's agreement, and also took 9/34 in another effort, 6 x 7 W/I, 21 x 5 W/I & two Hat Tricks. Won multiple Club Bowling Awards and served as 1st XI Captain, Office Bearer and long time Committee Member. He retired in 1912 after 28 seasons and continued to support the club on resumption post WW1, until he died aged 59 in 1923.
