

G.E. (George) Tew



Eldest son of legendary Clubman; Wal Tew. George dominated the Club bowling, alongside Barry Stuart throughout the 60's and early 70's. He took over 360 wickets, 16 X 5 W/I & 4 X 7 W/I with a best of 7/26. He won the FTGDCA 1st XI Bowling in the 1972/73 Premiership year & also won Club Bowling Averages as well as taking two Hat Tricks. He served on the Committee for over 12 terms – Treasurer for 9 & Secretary for 2 terms, continuing on the family legacy. George also represented the FTGDCA on many occasions and was honoured with Life Membership of the Club in 1969.
