

H.M. (Harry) Tew



Youngest son of legendary Clubman; Wal Tew. Rose through the Junior ranks with a pedigree that was destined for Senior XI stardom. Commenced senior cricket in the early 1960's and became a club great playing over 200 games. Scored over 3,800 runs (on record), 3 x 100's, 14 x 50's with a best of 129. Took over 180 wickets, 1 x 7 W/I, 5 x 5 W/I, 1 x 10 W/M inc 8/14 & 12/36 in the 1964/65 Semi Final; he then made 126 in the Grand Final. Harry led the 1st XI to the 1970/71 1st XI Flag, played in 6 Premierhips, represented the FTGDCA and was honoured with Life Membership of the Club in 1974.
