
G.J. (George) Williams



Commenced playing in 1883, and became the star all rounder of the pre WW1 era. He still holds the 1st XI record for most Runs in a Season (910) & 1st Wicket P/Ship with Fred Carrington (257). Scored 6 x 100's, 26 x 50's, took 5 x 7 W/I & 16 x 5 W/I, over 5000 career runs & 277 wickets from 169 games (On record). Won multiple Batting & Bowling Awards, 1st XI Captain, Office Bearer & long time Committee Member – retired in 1915 after 32 seasons & moved from the area to Box Hill during WW 1 and then became a 'scratch handicap' golfer, helping to create the Riversdale Golf Course.
