2/9/1886 **DA** GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB: A Meeting of the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB will be held at Grimwood's Ferntree Gully Hotel on Saturday evening next September 4th at 8:00 p.m. Business: Enrolment of members and arrangements for next season, also the various prizes won during the past season will be presented to the respective winners. A Meeting of the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB was held at Grimwood's Hotel last Saturday night. [Office Bearers elected were Patron G.M. Bruce Esq., President Dr. Moore, Vice Presidents T.S. Grimwood, J.T. Dobson, A. Smith, J. Kearney & H.C. Hayward \(Sic. – could be Heyward\)](#), Treasurer R. Minns, Secretary F.J. Charman, Captain W. Williams and Vice Captain F. Stevens.

8/9/1886 **SBMJ** A Meeting of the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB was held on Saturday evening last (4/9/1886) at the Ferntree Gully Hotel. Mr. T.S. Grimwood was voted to the chair who explained that the meeting had been called for the purpose of making arrangements and enrolment of members for the coming season. After some routine business had been transacted the election of Office Bearers proceeded, resulting as follows... [Patron: G.M. Bruce Esq, President: Dr. Moore, Vice Presidents: Messer's J.T. Dobson, T.S. Grimwood, H.C. Hayward \(Sic. – could be Heyward\), A. Smith and J. Kearney, Captain: Mr. W. Williams \(Re-elected\), Vice Captain: Mr. F. Stevens, Treasurer: Mr. R. Minns and Secretary: Mr. F.J. Charman.](#)

During the evening Mr. W. Williams was the recipient of a silver medal for the second batting average (A gift of Mr. Grimwood), Mr. Williams made a suitable reply. It was decided to present [Mr. F.J. Charman for his services rendered to the club in his capacity as Secretary](#), with a gold medal suitably inscribed. The first match of the season takes place on Saturday September 25th on the Glenfern ground.

9/9/1886 **DA** The advertised meeting of the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB took place on Saturday night last (4/9) at Mr. Grimwood's Ferntree Hotel, when there was a good muster of intending members. Mr. Grimwood presided. After some of last season's business had been dealt with, the following office bearers were elected for this season: [Patron: G.M. Bruce Esq, President: Dr. Moore, Vice Presidents: Messer's J.T. Dobson, T.S. Grimwood, H.C. Hayward \(Sic. – could be Heyward\), A. Smith and J. Kearney, Captain: Mr. W. Williams \(Re-elected\), Vice Captain: Mr. F. Stevens, Treasurer: Mr. R. Minns and Secretary: Mr. F.J. Charman.](#) The first match of the season takes place on Saturday September 25.

As a mark of esteem to the Secretary; [Mr. F.J. Charman](#), the club presented him with a gold medal, as a recognition of his services as secretary to the cricket clubs in Ferntree Gully. [NOTE: clubs \(plural\) – does this mean Charman was also Secretary of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB and the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB at the same time?](#)

Mr. W. Williams was the recipient of a silver medal for the second best batting average for last season, the gift of T.S. Grimwood Esq. Mr. Williams returned thanks. The subscription to the above club was fixed at 5s per annum. Votes of thanks to the chairman closed the meeting.

16/9/1886 **DA** GLENFERN vs NARRE WARREN (11/9/1886): GLENFERN 109 def NARRE WARREN 16 and 53. Tom Grimwood awards Cricket Bat for best batting average and a trophy for best bowling average. **Refer Scorebook.**

23/9/1886 **DA** The following will represent the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB next Saturday (25/9/1886) against RICHMOND on the ground of the former, play to commence at 1:00 p.m. – Williams (4), Stevens, A. Smith, W. Dawson, R. Smith, E. Selman, Charman and L'Oste with emergencies August, Grimwood and Rae. [The Secretary \(F.J. Charman\)](#) of the above club wishes to acknowledge with thanks the donation of £1 1s from Hotelier Mr. S. Grimwood – Melbourne.

29/9/1886 **SBMJ** The first cricket match of the season was played on Saturday last (25/9/1886) at Ferntree Gully. The home team, under the banner of the GLENFERN CLUB of the district, were certain of victory, having a select number chosen for the day, but contrary to their expectations they suffered a defeat at the hands of the visitors who journeyed from Armadale under the name of ARMADALE ROVERS. Mr. T. Grimwood prepared an excellent spread for both teams. **Refer Scorebook.**

30/9/1886 **DA** GLENFERN vs ARMADALE ROVERS: This match played on Saturday last (25/9/1886) on the ground of the former, it being the first match of the season and it so happened that the locals succumbed to a defeat at the hands of the visitors. Both teams were entertained at a dinner provided by host Grimwood in his well known style and ample justice was done to this important item by each representative so engaged. **Refer Scorebook.**

7/10/1886 **DA** BERWICK draw includes vs GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB 23/10 at Ferntree Gully and 26/2/1887 at Berwick.

13/10/1886 **SBMJ** Elsewhere in our columns the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB announce a concert and ball to celebrate the opening of the cricket season. The residents should "roll up" on the occasion and make the celebration something to be remembered.

14/10/1886 **DA** GLENFERN vs NARRE WARREN: These two clubs met on Saturday last (9/10/1886) at Narre Warren when the local team was easily put through at the hands of the active visitors. The ground chosen for the Wicket was rough which retarded some members making big scores and the heavy showers of rain that fell at intervals also made it unpleasant for a game of cricket. But despite these disadvantages the GLENFERN CLUB won by a large majority.

The GLENFERN CLUB at Ferntree Gully is commencing the season under the most favourable circumstances. Gifts and Donations are daily being received by the [Secretary \(F.J. Charman\)](#), who desires to acknowledge same with thanks. Mr. Grimwood, Ferntree Gully Hotel, gives a cricket net and a Trophy for Best Batting and Bowling Average combined for the present season. Mr. A. Smith, Lysterfield presents a bat to the value of 25s. Mr. W. Williams presents a medal for Best Batting. Mr. L'Oste gives a prize for best batting score and Mr. H.C. Hayward [\(Sic. – could be Heyward\)](#) gives a half a guinea donation.

21/10/1886 **DA** The DANDENONG CRICKET CLUB 1886/87 draw includes games against the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB on 18/12/1886 at Ferntree Gully and 19/2/1887 at Dandenong.

Next Saturday (23/10/1886) at 1:00 p.m. GLENFERN play BERWICK CRICKET CLUB on Glenfern ground. GLENFERN will be represented by W. Williams (Capt.), G & H. Williams, A. Smith, B. Smith, Selman, Dawson, Stevens, Bambury, Jackson, L'Oste – Emergencies: Grimwood, Hughes and Charman.

27/10/1886 **SBMJ** GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB: A Grand Concert & Ball (To celebrate the opening of the season of the above club) will be held in DOBSON'S HALL, FERNTREE GULLY, On TUESDAY, 9th NOVEMBER 1886 (Prince of Wales' Birthday.) Talent specially engaged for the concert. H.P. Hayward, Esq. J.P. will preside. Doors open at Half-past Seven, commence at eight sharp. Admission to Concert - Front seats, 2s; body of hall, 1s, To the Ball - Double (including refreshments), 5s, First class floor, an efficient M.C., with good music a leading feature, By order of the committee, F. J. CHARMAN, Hon. Sec

3/11/1886 **SBMJ** As announced elsewhere the grand concert and ball in connection with the opening of the cricket season by the GLENFERN CLUB takes place on the 9th inst. The promoters will doubtless be glad to see any number of visitors on the occasion.

4/11/1886 **DA** The following will represent the GLENFERN CLUB on Tuesday next (9/11/1886) against RICHMOND at the latter place: Armstrong, A. Smith, Stevens, Bambury, Jackson, Williams (4), E. Selman and W. Dawson. BERWICK CRICKET CLUB declined to respond to the match arranged with the GLENFERN CLUB, consequently no report is available.

24/11/1886 **SBMJ** The concert and ball given under the auspices of the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB turned out to be a great success. Dancing was kept up until the "wee sma" hours, some of the votaries of Terpsichore landing home just in time for their morning meal, which fact is sufficient proof that everything went off well and that all spent an enjoyable evening.

25/11/1886 **DA** The following will represent the GLENFERN CLUB on Thursday (2/12/1886) in the match versus PRAHRAN at the Gully commencing at 1:00 sharp: Williams (4), F. Stevens, E. Selman, W. Dawson, Smith (2), Bambury, Jackson and J.B. L'Oste.

27/11/1886 **PTEL** PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CRICKET CLUB: Next Thursday (2/12/1886) the first eleven play the FERNTREE GULLY, at Ferntree Gully, a drag leaving the town hall at 9 a.m. The following are the players: Armstrong, Birch, Ryall, Munro, Walker, Waller, Wartman, Conquest, Shields, Fletcher and Renfree.

27/11/1886 **STKT** PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CLUB: Next Thursday (2/12/1886) the first eleven play the FERNTREE GULLY, at Ferntree Gully, a drag leaving the town hall at 9 a.m. The following are the players: Armstrong, Birch, Ryall, Munro, Walker, Waller, Wartman, Conquest, Shields, Fletcher and Renfree.

2/12/1886 **ARGUS** PRAHRAN TRADES v. FERNTREE GULLY - The first eleven of the PRAHRAN TRADES will play the FERNTREE GULLY at the Gully today. The following team will leave by road at 9 a.m.: - Walker, Renfree, Ryall, Armstrong Shields, Munro, Birch Waller, Wartman, Fletcher and Patterson.

4/12/1886 **PTEL** PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CRICKET CLUB: On Thursday last (2/12/1886) the first eleven of the above club paid a visit to Ferntree Gully and played an eleven of the GLENFERN Club, the game resulting in a win for the GLENFERN by 42 runs. The total scores were 112 and 70. For PRAHRAN, Ryall 50 was the only one who showed any form. After the match the GLENFERN team entertained the PRAHRAN, when a very enjoyable time was spent.

4/12/1886 **STKT** PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CLUB: On Thursday last (2/12/1886) the first eleven of the above club paid a visit to Ferntree Gully and played an eleven of the GLENFERN club, the game resulting in a win for the GLENFERN by 42 runs; the total scores were 112 and 70. 16/12/1886 **DA** GLENFERN vs PRAHRAN TRADES: This match was played on Saturday last (11/12/1886) on the GLENFERN ground and ended in a win for the locals by 44 runs for which E. Selman played a splendid game, carrying his bat for 31 runs. G. Williams was next highest with 30 to his credit. For the visitors Ryall with 50 was their best scorer and displayed cricketing ability of no mean order. **Refer Scorebook.**

The match next Saturday (18/12/1886) is between GLENFERN and DANDENONG and is looked forward to with great interest - bets are made freely of new bats and 'quencher's' all round in favour of each club, the majority fancying DANDENONG.

20/1/1887 **DA** The following players will represent GLENFERN verses MALVERN next Saturday (22/1/1887) at Malvern: G. Williams, H. Williams, O. Williams, H. Richards, A. Smith, R. Smith, T. Smith, W. Dawson, E. Selman, J. Jackson and W. Bambury.

10/2/1887 **DA** GLENFERN vs NARRE WARREN (5/2/1887): Team members being Stevens, T. Williams, R. Smith, G. Williams, W. Williams, E. Selman, W. Dawson, W. Smith, A. Smith, Charman and Hughes with the Wicket takers being G. Williams 6, and R. Smith 3 and Narre Warren were 4/35 in their second innings. **Refer Scorebook.**

9/3/1887 **SBMJ** NARRE WARREN vs LYSTERFIELD: On Saturday last (5/3/1887) at Narre Warren. LYSTERFIELD 35 & 81 lost to NARRE WARREN 61 & 56 by 1 run.

16/3/1887 **SBMJ** Our Ferntree Gully correspondent writes that a cricket match commenced here on Saturday last (12/3/1887) between RINGWOOD and the GLENFERN CLUBS. The latter club went in first when three of their number put together 223 runs, Selman and Williams especially distinguishing themselves in wielding the willow.

17/3/1887 **DA** The GLENFERN CLUB takes on DANDENONG next Saturday (19/3/1887) at Dandenong with play commencing at 1:00 p.m. sharp.

24/3/1887 **DA** DANDENONG 100 def FERNTREE GULLY 40 (19/3/1887): Scores included O. Williams 4 Wickets, W. Williams 1 Wicket and G. Williams 5 Wickets while with the bat W. Williams was the only player to make double figures of 11. **Refer Scorebook.**

31/3/1887 **DA** On Saturday (26/3/1887) a match was played between LYSTERFIELD and NARRE WARREN on the Lysterfield ground and the visitors were victorious. **Refer Scorebook.**

GLENFERN vs NARRE WARREN played at Narre Warren South on the 2nd April

7/4/1887 **DA** The following will play for DANDENONG against LYSTERFIELD on the Dandenong Cricket Ground next Saturday (9/4/1887) ...

14/4/1887 **DA** DANDENONG soundly defeated LYSTERFIELD at Lysterfield (9/4/1887) by 139 runs, 189 to 50. Playing for LYSTERFIELD were W. Williams 3, G. Williams 25, H. Williams 0, R. Smith 14, W. Smith 4, Munro 0, W. Dawson 3, T. Smith 0, A. Smith 0, Deerhound 1 and Malone 0, while the Wicket takers were R. Smith 3, W. Williams 3, H. Williams 2 and T. Smith 1. **Refer Scorebook.**

28/4/1887 **DA** GLENFERN vs RICHMOND: This match was played on the Richmond ground on 8 hours day (Monday 25/4/1887), terminating in a good win for the GLENFERN CLUB. **Refer Scorebook.**

30/4/1887 **AGE** A team from the RICHMOND CLUB will play a match today (30/4/1887) against the GLENFERN CLUB, at Ferntree Gully. The following players will represent RICHMOND – Shand, McDowell, Matthews, Bennett, Hodges, Brock (2), McDonald, Stillman, Sinclair, McMillan, Grant, Valentine and Wright.

30/4/1887 **ARGUS** A team from the RICHMOND CLUB will play a match today (30/4/1887) against the GLENFERN CLUB, at Ferntree Gully. The following players will represent RICHMOND – Shand, McDowell, Matthews, Bennett, Hodges, Brock (2), McDonald, Stillman, Sinclair, McMillan, Grant, Valentine and Wright.

4/5/1887 **SPMAN** A team of RICHMOND cricketers terminated the season in a very pleasant manner on Saturday (30/4/1887), a trip to Ferntree Gully to play the GLENFERN CRICKET CLUB being arranged by the indefatigable secretary, Mr. H. Brock, and carried out to the manifest satisfaction of both sides. RICHMOND batted first and scored 46.

Grant (17 not out), Grace (11), Matthews (7) and McMillan (6) played well for their runs; while the brothers Williams with 18 and 13 were amongst the top scorers for GLENFERN. The match terminated in a win for the latter by seven wickets. A good day's sport was brought to a close by the visitors being entertained in sumptuous style, a dinner at Grimwood's having ample justice done to it.

25/5/1887 **SBMJ** **FTGFC** The cricketing season has terminated and for the first time in Ferntree Gully a FOOTBALL CLUB is about to be formed, so between quoits and football we look forward to plenty of amusement during the winter months. **NOTE: This is the first mention of football being played or a club being formed in Ferntree Gully.**
