Newspaper Notes

16/10/1908 **BHR** Mr. Harry Pickett, local cricket stalwart has had an unfortunate turn of news in his family with his two children laid up with sickness and now his wife, who took suddenly ill last week died last Monday. The community passes on its best wishes and support to Mr. Pickett will be large in coming forward given his standing in the community.

28/10/1908 **SBMJ** Next Saturday (31/10/1908) MULGRAVE visit FERNTREE GULLY, and player are requested to be at the Ground early

6/11/1908 **BHR** Large article on the complimentary social and presentation held at Box Hill, and sponsored by the Reporter, which includes in the following notes... that E.F.G. Hodges would like to see the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET and FOOTBALL CLUBS in the respective competitions in 1908 and 1909.

7/11/1908 **OFTG** A match between FERNTREE GULLY and MULGRAVE was played at Ferntree Gully last Saturday (31/10/1908) and resulted in a win for the visitors by 25 runs, 99 to 74. FERNTREE GULLY batted 12 men while MULGRAVE batted 13. **Refer Scorebook.**

11/11/1908 **SBMJ** The MULGRAVE CRICKET CLUB visited Ferntree Gully on the 31st and played the local team, when the game resulted in a win for the visitors by 24 runs. **Refer Scorebook.**

13/11/1908 **BHR** Notice has been received from the Ferntree Gully Tennis Club, seeking permission to enter the newly established RECREATION GROUND and erect a tennis court thereon. Cr. Monk moved, and Cr. Lyons seconded, that the request be granted and that the riding members and the clerk of works view the ground and select an appropriate site for construction to commence.

27/11/1908 **BHR** Ferntree Gully Tennis Club; About 12 months ago the first step was taken to adapt the property bought by the shire council into a RECREATION RESERVE for the Centre riding. The government having voted £60 for the improving of the ground, the second step was taken when tenders were called for fencing the reserve with a cyclone fence. On Saturday night a further advance was made, when the new Ferntree Gully tennis club organised a concert and short dance to raise funds for the new tennis court. The progress has been a bit slow certainly, but it has been progress and that is worthy of note.

The young people have made a start, and they have only to stick together to make the 8 acres into a RECREATION GROUND which will be a credit to the shire; but as the president, who presided over the gathering on Saturday, pointed out it rests with the people themselves. He hoped it would not be long before a bowling club was started and instanced the splendid advertisement the bowling club had given to Box Hill.

11/12/1908 **SPORT** GOVERNMENT PRINTING OFFICE vs FERNTREE GULLY; Played at Ferntree Gully on Saturday 5/12/1908. GPO 52, J. Willis 13, G. Rain 9, J. Opie 8), FERNTREE GULLY 138 (B. Town 38, J. Cox 37, A. Pickett 20, H. Pickett 18, T. Rider 3/26, G. Robinson 3/29, A. Stuckey 1/26, G. Rain 1/22), FERNTREE GULLY bowling, J. Cox 3/15, B. Town 5/18. GPO was handicapped by the absence of several of their leading players, notably their fine bowler, E. Duffy.

31/12/1908 **DA** The BELGRAVE CRICKET CLUB has, for the purposes of this holiday season amalgamated with FERNTREE GULLY to provide a match for those who are in the district for their social benefit. Prizes were awarded to the best Batsman – W. Cox and Best Bowling R. Biffin.

13/1/1909 **SBMJ** MULGRAVE played FERNTREE GULLY on the local ground last Saturday and resulted in a win for the visitors by 4 wickets and 37 runs. **Refer Scorebook.**

15/1/1909 **BHR** The Ferntree Gully Tennis Club has now some £50 odd in hand and is now only waiting for the Centre Riding members to meet and select the site within the bounds of the new RECREATION RESERVE. Unless the site is chosen at once, very little can be done this season and the members are becoming somewhat anxious in awaiting their Club's fate.

16/1/1909 **OFTG** The match between MULGRAVE and FERNTREE GULLY was played last Saturday at Mulgrave and resulted in a win for the visitors 6/137 to 100. **Refer Scorebook.**

12/2/1909 **BHR** Since a paragraph appeared in these columns about the Ferntree Gully tennis court, the riding members have met and arranged for the site. Now that was very nice of them, but their efforts were not appreciated as they should have been. When the hon. secretary called a meeting of members to decide upon the laying out of the new courts only one member answered the roll call, and that was the lady treasurer. Members that is bad and is not much encouragement to your councillors who have secured you a RECREATION GROUND of 7 acres and just nicely fenced it in for you with a cyclone fence. Surely some effort might be made to rouse interest in the matter.

17/3/1909 **SBMJ** The MULGRAVE cricketers visited Ferntree Gully on Saturday and met defeat at the hands of the locals who had a surplus of 42 runs for the loss of 8 wickets. **Refer Scorebook.**

20/3/1909 **OFTG** MULGRAVE visited Ferntree Gully in their return match with the result being the same – Victory to FERNTREE GULLY with 9/121 to 8/79. **Refer Scorebook.**

16/4/1909 **BHR** From Lands department, stating that £25 has been allotted to the FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION GROUND on condition that the shire add £12 10/-. President and Centre riding members to inspect the ground and report as to expenditure.
