WIN/LOSS ORDER:

6/9/1912 **BHR** *Cr. Monk moved and Cr. Pickett seconded that the clerk of works have a cricket pitch put down in the recreation ground, and that the commissioners be asked to appoint a Station master at Lower Fern Tree Gully.*

Though cricket was played (and published) continuously between September and the final round Saturday 26th April 1913, there are no other reports of matches in which Ferntree Gully participated other than those above.

It is also likely that even though matches were by arrangement that games would have taken place on the Saturday's in October and on the 9th and 30th November. In addition matches are also likely to have been played on 25th January 1913, and throughout the remaining Saturdays in February, March and April.

Reports of arranged matches by Bayswater continued through until May 1913...

Effectively we are missing the results from three victories & one loss while it is probable that among the six drawn games some were affected by weather and may have actually commenced with achievements applying to some players.

Newspaper Notes

10/5/1912 **BHR** Thanks to the courtesy of the LILYDALE club in exchanging dates, the opening ceremony of the new ground and grand stand will take place on May 25. The state member for the district and others, besides the president and councilors, will be present to see the match and perform the opening ceremony. The oval has been set out at 150 yards by 120 yards and is now looking well. Every accommodation has been made for visitors without going off the ground, which is close to the Lower Ferntree Gully station, facing the shire hall, and in the township. Special arrangements have been made with the proprietor of the Ferntree Gully hotel (Mr. E. Lording) for a tea for those teams who require it. Mrs. Lording is noted for the excellence of her catering, and visitors are assured of a pleasant time when visiting Ferntree Gully. The shire council has spared no expense to make a thoroughly up-to-date RECREATION GROUND.

The opening ceremony for the new RECREATION RESERVE is scheduled for 25/5/1912.

30/5/1912 **DA** New Pavilion and RECREATION RESERVE declared open 25/5/1912 – current old ground and Scout Hall location, where the Football and Cricket oval is reached by two rustic bridges spanning the verdure clad Ferny Creek.

30/5/1912 **SBMJ** Advertisement for sale of Lower Ferntree Gully 'Club Hotel' including 10 acres of land and sports playing field, general store and bakery, under the power of Executors of Mrs. Anne Freeman's estate.

30/5/1912 **SBMJ** Advertising for Tuesday 11/6/1912 for the sale of the Club Hotel with land, about 10 ½ acres, including the local cricket ground, general store and bakery, after finalisation of Annie Freeman's estate.

NOTE: This cricket ground became superfluous to needs, with the development of the RECREATION RESERVE OVAL c1910, which was formally opened 25th May 1912. Before this the predominant playing field used by the two clubs and community was at the rear of the Ferntree Gully "Middle" Hotel.

6/9/1912 **BHR** **FTGFC** FTGFC celebrated their 1912 Box Hill "Reporter" Premiership in royal fashion at the Shire Hall with a presentation, concert and dance. Refer Newspaper Report.

Cr. Monk moved, and Cr. Pickett seconded that the clerk of works have a CRICKET PITCH put down in the RECREATION GROUND, and that the commissioners be asked to appoint a station master at Lower Ferntree Gully. **NOTE: This is the first reference to cricket being prepared for on the NEW RECREATION RESERVE.**

8/11/1912 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY played a match against MORELAND last Saturday and went down by 6 runs, MORELAND 184 to FERNTREE GULLY 178 of which V. Carey contributed 132 not out. **Refer Scorebook.**

22/11/1912 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY played against SWALLOW & ARIELL, and the visitors were victorious by 40 runs, SWALLOW & ARIELL 90 to FERNTREE GULLY 50. **Refer Scorebook.**

29/11/1912 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY took on the ENGINEERS and was defeated by the visitors by 51 runs, ENGINEERS 6/142 to FERNTREE GULLY 91. **Refer Scorebook.**

13/12/1912 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY played a match against ROSELLA last Saturday and was victorious 4/177 to the visitors 36. The game was dominated by V. Carey who took 7/7 and made 48. **Refer Scorebook.**

14/12/1912 **FOOTI** During the holidays the FOOTSCRAY PROTESTANT ALLIANCE CLUB will play matches against LOWER FERNTREE GULLY, BELGRAVE and WOODSTOCK Clubs.

20/12/1912 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY played MELBOURNE YARDS last Saturday when they were victorious by 6 wickets and 15 runs. **Refer Scorebook.** Bayswater play FERNTREE GULLY at Bayswater on Saturday next, December 21st.

3/1/1913 **BHR** BAYSWATER were at home to FERNTREE GULLY Saturday 20th December and gave the visitors a taste of defeat, Scores being BAYSWATER 116 to FERNTREE GULLY 44 resulting in a 72 run win. In a match against EMERALD on Saturday 27th December FERNTREE GULLY 9/177 defeated EMERALD 9/95. **Refer Scorebook.** Correspondence in Council Minutes records that T.M. Heaney proposed a road past the new RECREATION RESERVE linking Main Road and Glenfern Roads i.e. now "Lysterfield Road", the matter being held over for one month on the motion of Cr. H. Monk and seconded by Cr. Pickett.

EMERALD v. FERNTREE GULLY; EMERALD cricket club journey to the Gully on Saturday last and were treated well by the GULLY CRICKET CLUB. The results are as follows: - FERNTREE GULLY, 9 wickets. for 177 (Williams 84, Wakeham 22, Foster 18, Head 15, Monk 11), C.P. Nobelius securing 5 wickets for 37 runs. EMERALD, 9 wickets for 95 (C.P. Nobelius 43, A.V. Nobelius 15, C.L. Nobelius 12, Watts 2 wickets, 9 runs, Foster 1 for 1, Pickets 2 for 17). FERNTREE GULLY won by 82 runs,

10/1/1913 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY were visited by FOOTSCRAY ALLIANCE who batted first at the loss of the toss and the request of FERNTREE GULLY'S captain. The ALLIANCE team made a very good 208 runs but were surpassed by the locals who made 5/225 thus being victorious by 25 runs and 5 wickets. The major contribution came from V. Carey with his second century of the season, 134 and a first Wicket Partnership of 169 runs with A.J. (Alexander Joseph) Charman. **Refer Scorebook.**

11/1/1913 **FOOTI** PROTESTANT ALLIANCE ON TOUR – By one of them; The FOOTSCRAY PROTESTANT ALLIANCE C.C., left for Ferntree Gully on Boxing Day to play the FERNTREE GULLY IMPERIALS. The party was large and merry, and included some first class vocalists from the Footscray senior team, and last but not least our friends: "Joe the Goose" and "Short Circuit", who were also in good form. On arriving at Ferntree Gully, we were disagreeably surprised to learn that we had a nice little walk of two miles before us, but eventually we reached our destination, and after partaking of an excellent dinner commenced the game.

Skipper, H. Lloyd won the toss and batted, and did well in compiling 208 in two hours and twenty minutes against some fine bowling. Chief scorers for ALLIANCE were H. Lloyd (80 Ret), Johnson 22, W. Powrie 21, A. Johansson 19, L. Stevens 17 and W. Sutton 15. FERNTREE GULLY followed and with only two hours to bat, owing to the efforts of V. Carey (134) and A. Charman (65), compiled 225, thus winning by 17 runs. Carey for FERNTREE GULLY gave a fine exhibition of hitting but was badly missed on several occasions. Charman gave the soundest exhibition of the two. Skipper Lloyd followed up his fine batting by bowling well but suffered owing to the bad fielding. Johansson also bowled really well.

17/1/1913 **BHR** FERNTREE GULLY was at home to BAYSWATER who dealt the locals yet another defeat by scoring 5/146 and routing them for 87. **Refer Scorebook.**

24/1/1913 **BHR** HENRY BERRY & CO. visited the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB on Saturday last and tried conclusions. They were heavily defeated by the locals with V. Carey again to the fore with efforts of 95 not out with the bat and 4/19 with the ball. **Refer Scorebook.**

31/1/1913 **BHR** Establishment of Belgrave Progress Association, BAYSWATER and FERNTREE GULLY met again with the results being somewhat different to last time these combatants met a few weeks ago. This time FERNTREE GULLY were victorious making 8/112 to BAYSWATER'S 8/96 at the close of play. **Refer Scorebook.**

14/2/1913 **BHR** The FERNTREE GULLY cricketers visited EMERALD on Saturday last and the game resulted in a substantial win for the GULLYITES who batted first and scored 170. Carey and Rutherford batted splendidly scoring 88 and 35 respectively while others to make double figures were McMahon 15 and F. Pickett 10.

In reply EMERALD (batting 12) were dismissed for 73, the best of the GULLY bowlers being V. Carey 6/15, J. McMahon 3/5, A. Pickett 1/9 and F. Carrington 1/15. The EMERALD club catered for the visitors in a splendid manner and the GULLY boys voted it the best trip of the season and vowed to come up again next season. **Refer Scorebook.**

3/3/1913 **AGE** FERN TREE GULLY 90 (Minns 22, Treloar 21; Hopgood eight for 15) v. MISSION six for 175 (Makin 98, Greig 34 not out, Quirk 14, Pratt 16 not out) - played Saturday 1/3/1913.

25/4/1913 **BHR** Now that the new RECREATION RESERVE is getting in fine order Cr. A.E. Selman thought that something should be done to let the people of Melbourne and suburbs know that a good and convenient ground was available for firms and clubs to hold their annual outings.

It was therefore resolved that the Secretary take steps to advertise the ground and bring it under the attention of firms who might be too pleased to avail themselves of a handy sports ground. The ground comprises 8 ½ acres, almost square, and gives ample room for any class of sport. There is a fine cover of grass now and any small patches of clay face have been top dressed and rolled.
