Newspaper Notes

17/9/1927 **FTGN** The **Annual Meeting** of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB was held at Soldier's Hall on Wednesday night but was poorly attended. After a lengthy discussion it was decided to disband and the material on hand has been offered to the U.A.O.D. Lodge. The trophy for best all rounder was awarded to George Meredith, whose batting average was 24.17 and whose bowling efforts yielded 36 wickets for 325 runs at an average of 9.6. J. Rowe who had bowled 45 overs for the splendid average of 7.6 had the best figures, but the rules state that a minimum of 50 overs must be bowled for average purposes, hence the bowling trophy was awarded to T. Daykin whose 132 overs resulted in 43 wickets at an average of 11.7. Doug Bear with an average of 28 won the batting award. The U.A.O.D. Lodge, Ferntree Gully will form a cricket team to play social cricket his season. Mr. A.F. Pickett was accorded the first Life Governorship of the Football Association at a meeting last Thursday evening.

8/10/1927 **FTGN** Mr. G.A. Lovell has organised the Ferntree Gully Sporting Carnival at the RECREATION RESERVE and has requested Council consider an application for a Bathing complex to be built at the ground to complement the existing Spectator Stand, Rooms and other minor improvements that make this area a central part of the Ferntree Gully community. The efforts of the community and sporting clubs that use these facilities has done much to assist council in their ground maintenance program.

22/10/1927 **FTGN** The U.A.O.D. Club commenced their first match against the PROVINCIAL CRICKET CLUB on the Club Hotel ground last Saturday (owing to the Girl Guides activity display being on the Ferntree Gully ground) and had a very enjoyable game. The game will be concluded on the Ferntree Gully ground this afternoon. The U.A.O.D. made 117 and had their opponents 3/64 when time was called. **Refer Scorebook.**

29/10/1927 **FTGN** The above match was concluded on Saturday last at the Ferntree Gully ground and resulted in a victory for the visitors by 25 runs on first innings. Scores were DRUIDS 117 & 2/94 to PROVINCIALS 142. **Refer Scorebook.**

5/11/1927 **FTGN** Playing for BORONIA against RINGWOOD CENTRALS were E. Beaumont, J. Rowe and F. Pickett while turning out for UPPER FERNTREE GULLY against ROSELLA RAMBLERS were D. Bear and W. Swindon.

12/11/1927 **FTGN** In the match between the FERNTREE GULLY DRUIDS and the "AGE SECOND XI" the locals were victorious by 6 wickets and 21 runs. **Refer Scorebook.** Turning out for UFTG against RINGWOOD CENTRALS were D. Bear, W. Swindon and L. Ewart while in School cricket the Ferntree Gully school played a match against Belgrave at Belgrave and the result was FTG 5/55 (A. Ford 30*, C. Williamson 7 and G. Pickett 7) to Belgrave all out 27. Representing SCORESBY CRICKET CLUB were G. Williams (Jnr.), G. Peel and S. Johnstone.

19/11/1927 **FTGN** The DRUIDS played a match against MAX MINTS on Saturday last and had a victory by three wickets and nine runs. **Refer Scorebook.** Turning out for BORONIA against KILSYTH were E. Beaumont, J. Rowe and F. Pickett.

21/11/1927 **AGE** FERNTREE GULLY, Saturday — Upper Ferntree Gully 148 (Richardson 63; Tainsh 36; Eddy five for 30, Page two for 18) lost to Upwey eight for 157 (A. Miller 54, Eddy 24, Morse 28).

3/1/1928 **AGE** UPPER FERNTREE GULLY 134 (Ludlow 55 not out, Bear 18; Beach three for 19, McKay three for 17) defeated "THE AGE" second eleven 80 (Wilkins 21, Beach 11; Kronk seven for 19, Swindon two for 3, Martin one for 6). UPPER FERNTREE GULLY 165 (McAllan 61, Hede 30, Martin 21; Moody three for 48, Waller two for 14) lost to NEW STREET METHODISTS 190 (Giles 88, C. Swain 30, R. Swain 23; Swindon five for 52, Brown two for 34).

14/1/1928 **FTGN** The DRUIDS played a match against the TOURIST BUREAU, which they won comfortably by 79 runs, 4/155 to 76. **Refer Scorebook.** In the match between UPPER FERNTREE GULLY and UPWEY the UPPER GULLY team was represented by W. Swindon, L.D. Bear, F. Hede Snr., F. Hede Jnr. and E. Rosenbrock while the game between BORONIA and CROYDON had J. Rowe and E. Beaumont represented

23/1/1928 **AGE** UPPER FERNTREE GULLY, Sunday - UPPER FERNTREE GULLY seven for 152 (dec.) (Rosenbrock 60, Bear 33; Leonard two for 11, Gibbs two for 26) d. UPWEY 32 (Gibbs 15; Swindon five for 11 including hat trick; Kronk two for 12).

4/2/1928 **FTGN** UPPER FERNTREE GULLY played POSTAL RAMBLERS and fielded a team including W. Swindon, F. Hede Snr., F. Hede Jnr., L.D. Bear and E. Rosenbrock. In the match between U.A.O.D. and STAR OF RICHMOND the game resulted in a victory for the locals by 16 runs. **Refer Scorebook.**

3/3/1928 **AGE** FERNTREE GULLY, Friday. — The following have been chosen to represent the Mountain District at country week: Jorgensen, S. Lennard, E. Fleming, J. Page, A. Nobelius, C. Gramlick, H. Smith, J. Alexander, W. Allen, W. Edyvane, N. Mellor, W. Coombe, J. May, G. Chandler, P. James, B. Cheong, C. Hunt.

24/3/1928 **FTGN** A match was played between U.A.O.D. and UPPER FERNTREE GULLY over two days commencing last Saturday at the FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION RESERVE. Campbell lost the toss and his opponent Bear elected to bat. The UPPER GULLY innings concluded at 141 with Sutton 4/36, Daykin 2/27, J. Pickett 1/35 and Campbell 3/20 the successful bowlers. In reply the DRUIDS are 2/77. **Refer Scorebook.**

26/3/1928 **AGE** FERNTREE GULLY, Saturday — UPPER FERNTREE GULLY 141 (Jennings 54, Tainsh 27, Best 20; Sutton four for 36, Campbell three for 20) and five for 54 (dec.) (M. Henry 19; Daykin three for 34) lost to FERNTREE GULLY DRUIDS 143 (W. Pickett 33, Hayes 20; Hede two for 6, Swindon three for 43 and two for 58, Daykin 30 not out).

31/3/1928 **FTGN** The above match concluded last Saturday, and very little more excitement could be desired at the finish of the DRUIDS first innings against UPPER GULLY. When the match resumed on Saturday the DRUIDS were in a winning position at 2/77 and with time at their disposal and 8 wickets in hand needed to add 64 to claim victory. On the other hand, UPPER GULLY had the runs on the board, and so both teams were expectant of victory. The laurels and spoils of victory finally rested with the DRUIDS who prevailed by 2 runs. In pursuit of an outright result Bear realising the fluctuations of the game and with nothing to lose gave his team instructions to force matters in their second attempt, with the result that after 35 minutes batting he declared at 5/54. This left 50 minutes to get the DRUIDS out or the DRUIDS to gain an outright victory.

They took up the challenge and with only minutes to spare they achieved their desired result being only 2 down for 58 runs. The DRUIDS fielding was of a better standard than that of their opponents and this influenced the result. **Refer Scorebook.**

14/4/1928 **FTGN** Advertisement for U.A.O.D. – Join the Druids – Do it now, The UNITED ANCIENT ORDER of DRUIDS have opened a new lodge at the Ferntree Gully Memorial Hall, Meetings every alternate Wednesday at 8:00 p.m., low contributions, big benefits and full particulars are available from F.J. Staig, Secretary of Chaundy Street Ferntree Gully.

30/4/1928 **AGE** FERNTREE GULLY Schemes - Improvement Works Opened. FERNTREE GULLY, Sunday - The new works carried out on the FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION GROUND were officially opened on Saturday in the presence of a large number of ratepayers. The new bridge over the FERNTREE GULLY Creek was declared opened by the shire president, Cr. R.O. Cowey, J.P., Mrs. Cowey cutting the ribbon with a pair of silver scissors presented by Mr. W. Tyner, M.L.C. The ribbon was held by two of the oldest residents, Mr. Robert Hughes, who has resided here for 72 years, and ex - Cr. Ellis Hughes, of 54 years' standing. The tennis courts were also declared open by Cr. R.O. Cowey.

Mr. Tyner, M.L.C., congratulated the council on its foresight in making provision for this fine reserve fourteen years ago, when land was fairly cheap. To acquire a ground similar in size at the present time would be a big financial drain on the funds of the shire. He could not understand the withholding of an extension of the suburban radius to such places as Upper FERNTREE GULLY, Lilydale and Frankston. The tourist resorts in this district were equal to anything in the world. He had seen the scenery in the Rockies and in Switzerland, and although we had not the high mountain peaks as in those places, our scenery in comparison was equal, if not better.

The new works, which consist of a new bridge over the creek, new pavilion and grand stand on the playing area, top dressing of the tennis courts and general repairs, cost £400. Money has been invested at fixed deposit to help in providing swimming baths at an early date. At the recent carnival £320 was raised for improvements for the reserve.

30/4/1928 **ARGUS** FERNTREE GULLY RESERVE Official Opening: FERNTREE GULLY, Sunday — The official opening of the improved FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION RESERVE was performed yesterday afternoon. Councillor J. G. S. Ford, chairman of the reserve committee, presided. Mr. Tyner, M.L.C., presented Mrs. Cowey, wife of the shire president (Councillor R. O. Cowey), with a pair of silver scissors in case to cut the ribbon which was held across the entrance of the new footbridge. One end of the ribbon was held by Mr Hughes, who was a councillor 52 years ago, and the other end by Mr W. Hughes, a resident of 72 years.

Councillor R. O. Cowey, in declaring the ground open, said that some hundreds, of pounds had been raised by a carnival, and, after providing the new bridge, new pavilion, rebuilding two asphalt tennis courts, and carrying out other works, the committee had been able to put £130 on fixed deposit towards providing swimming baths. Since taking over 18 months ago the present committee had spent more than £400 in addition to what had been done in voluntary labour. Some years before the war the council had purchased these seven and a half acres from the Ashley estate. It was then bushland, full of deep gullies, and covered with blackberries. It was cleared; the gullies filled up, fenced, and graded and planted with English grass and ornamental trees.

The arena which was 180 yards between goal-posts by 130 yards wide was underground drained, banked and fenced off, the result being one of the most beautiful reserves in the State. Later at the opening of the tennis courts, Councillor J. G. S. Ford referred to the probability of the shire obtaining a water supply from the metropolitan system when croquet and bowling greens would be provided. Mr Tyner said that he hoped that before long the Railways Commissioners would be able to extend the suburban radius to Upper Ferntree Gully. He would do all he could to retain the local line of buses on the road, as they were an absolute necessity to the district.

A vote of thanks was passed to Mr T. M. Heany (shire engineer) for services given, Mr. T. Horan for valuable assistance, and Mr G. Lovell, hon. secretary.

24/7/1928 **ARGUS** FERNTREE GULLY; Mr. A.F. Pickett has been elected a member of the FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION RESERVE committee.

23/8/1928 **HER** Billiards Skill The standard of billiards skill - professional and amateur— has been vastly raised since the Victorian Club tournament was instituted. Mr E. Eccles, one of the recent winners, attained to the altitude of amateur champion of Victoria. Many aspirants have piled up three-figure breaks in private. The losing hazard is employed with a deadly effectiveness that was undreamt of by pioneer cueists.

Yet in the opinion of veterans no present-day player can compare with the late MR. SAM GRIMWOOD, who showed his superiority half a century ago. MR. GRIMWOOD moved to Perth (W.A.), and I saw him take part in an exhibition game at the Palace Hotel, St. George's Terrace, in the late 90's. Any dispute regarding, billiards was left to Sam's determination in the capital of the gold State. A finer old sport could not be found.

Some readers may remember GRIMWOOD'S father (TOM) as landlord of the Rose and Thistle Hotel, on the east side of Elizabeth street, between Little Bourke and Lonsdale streets. Opposite that hostelry was the Bush Inn, from which cabs plied to Flemington and Moonee Valley.
