# Newspaper Notes

**13/10/1880** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs FERNTREE GULLY: On Saturday last (9/10/1880) a match was played between the FERNTREE GULLY and SCORESBY CRICKET CLUBS on the ground of the former. Owing to some delay the match was not commenced at the appointed time and the consequence was that there was insufficient time to play the usual two innings. The game was decided by the first innings and resulted in a win for FERNTREE GULLY. In justice to SCORESBY, it is only fair to state that when time was called there were four wickets to fall and only 22 runs to make to win. **Refer Scorebook.**

**20/10/1880** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs SPRINGVALE: A match between the two above named clubs took place at Scoresby on Saturday last (16/10/1880) and resulted in a victory for SPRINGVALE with four wickets to spare. **Refer Scorebook.**

**17/11/1880** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs BARKER'S HILL: Representatives of SCORESBY and BARKER'S HILL CRICKET CLUBS (near Mulgrave) met for the first time during the present season on Saturday last (13/11/1880) at Barker's Hill. High scores were the order of the day, owing perhaps to the adverse influence exerted on the fielders by the oppressive state of the weather. Altogether, the fielding of the respective teams was anything but good; however, some of the batsmen displayed an exhibition of genius cricket. The two batsmen who most distinguished themselves were Charman for SCORESBY and Bennett for BARKER'S HILL. The match resulted in a draw as there was insufficient time to play it out. **Refer Scorebook.**

**15/12/1880** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs SPRINGVALE: A very pleasant game was played between SCORESBY and SPRINGVALE on Saturday last (11/12/1880) at Springvale and resulted in a rather easy victory for SPRINGVALE. **Refer Scorebook.**

**ADVERTISEMENT:** Mr. R. Crabb: Travelling agent for the Australian Widow's Fund Life Assurance Society, will deliver his popular lecture in the Schoolroom on Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup> inst. Proceeds on behalf of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB, Ladies specially invited.

**22/12/1880** **SBMJ** Mr. Crabb on behalf of the Australian Widow's Fund Life Assurance Society delivered his lecture on Saturday evening last at the Ferntree Gully School in aid of the CRICKET CLUB. The title of the lecture was "Home Life" and the building on this occasion was crowded. The evening generated funds of £3 to the benefit of the CRICKET CLUB.

**3/1/1881** **SBMJ** Ferntree Gully: General Store with Bakery to let, Proprietor leaving district, 15 Acres of land, Apply Robert Walker, 25 Swanston Street, Melbourne. **NOTE: It is believed that this site was adjacent to the Huntingtower Hotel and became the area associated with the first 'home' playing venue, i.e. what is now the land occupied by the current Club Hotel car park.**

**26/1/1881** **SBMJ** DANDENONG vs SCORESBY: A cricket match took place in the park, Dandenong, between the above clubs on Saturday last (22/1/1881) and resulted in a decisive victory for DANDENONG by six wickets owing to the vigorous batting of Dowell and G. Dobson, who scored over 60 runs between them. In the second innings, each not out the principal scorers were, for DANDENONG: Dowell with 12 and 39 not out; Dobson 0 and 23 not out; M. Evans 19 and 4; Hyde Snr 10 and 0. For SCORESBY Johnson with 20 not out and 8; E. Hughes with 13 was the principal scorers.

Owing to the first innings of the SCORESBY team not being scored in the book, no correctness can be arrived at and this is the reason why the scores do not appear in full. For bowling Hyde and Dobson carried off the honours for DANDENONG and for SCORESBY, Kennedy and McComb trundled very well. Godding at mid-wicket distinguished himself by catching no less than four of his opponents out. The scores were for SCORESBY 76 and 52 and for DANDENONG 55 and four wickets for 78.

**9/2/1881** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs DANDENONG: These clubs met again for the second time this season (5/2/1881) and had a very pleasant game together and the result was another victory for DANDENONG by five wickets to spare. **Refer Scorebook.**

**12/2/1881** **PTEL** Next Thursday the members of the PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CRICKET CLUB will visit Ferntree Gully for the purpose of playing a friendly game with the cricketers of that place. A start will be made from the Prahran Town Hall at 4 o'clock in the morning, so as to enable them to see the Gully before the match commences. Mr. Becker of Windsor has undertaken all arrangements for the catering department, and Mr. Batchelder, wagonette proprietor, will supply the conveyances necessary for the occasion. A good muster of the tradesmen is expected.

**19/2/1881** **STKT** **SPORTS CHRONICLE – TRIP TO FERNTREE GULLY** - About 3 o'clock last Thursday morning several persons were observed perambulating Chapel and High streets, knocking up the people at various houses on their way. Half an hour later three pair-horse wagonettes appeared in Chapel street, containing twenty persons, and, upon following them up Chapel street as far as Lording's Railway Hotel where they halted, we found, on inquiry, that the party consisted of several members of the PRAHRAN TRADESMEN'S CRICKET CLUB, who were on their way to Ferntree Gully to play the cricketers of that place a friendly game of cricket.

After partaking of an excellent breakfast supplied by Mrs. Lording, a start was made at 3.35. Upon reaching Oakleigh a halt was made at the Foresters' Arms Hotel, where refreshments were again partaken of, supplied this time by another old Prahranite (Mrs. Edwards, late of the Prince of Wales Hotel, Chapel Street). After a short stay, the party proceeded onwards, and arrived at the Hunting Tower Hotel at about a quarter past seven. When within about three miles of the hotel, a horseman was observed to be galloping after the party at full speed, who, upon catching up with the first wagonette, reined up, and was noticed to take stock of the occupants. Presently, the stranger was recognised as a mounted trooper in plain clothes.

Excitement then ran high as to what he wanted, and it was supposed that, having seen the party alight at Oakleigh, and consisting entirely of the male sex, he surmised they were going out to have a prize-fight, or some other game at which his presence might be needed. However, after having inspected the other wagonettes, he appeared to be satisfied and proceeded onwards. An hour's cricket practice was then indulged in, and about 9 o'clock another breakfast was partaken of, and at 10 o'clock a start was made for the Gully. Upon arriving at the foot of the Gully, a halt was made, and it having been ascertained that all hands were present (with the exception of the Brothers Lording, who had gone off to visit some friends), a race was started up the Gully. Messrs Dixon, Crook, Reed, and Elton were forced to retire soon after entering the Gully, finding the road too steep and the pace too hot; the others, consisting of Messrs. Stewart, Emery, Davies, Warburton, Semple, Smith: J., Smith C, Merrett, Jackson, Chiel, Linay, Taylor, Carter, and Becker, persevered onwards. Messrs. Stewart and Emery followed closely by Davies, Semple, and Warburton being the first to reach the top. After retiring for about an hour, a start was made homewards, and the Hunting Tower Hotel was reached just in time for dinner.

At 2 o'clock the match was commenced. The FERNTREE GULLY CRICKETERS, having won the toss, decided to bat first and were not disposed of until 38 runs had been made. This score, small as it appeared, was thought too much for the PRAHRANITES, especially after having had no sleep the previous night, and after the exertions of going up the Gully during the morning. However, they went in determined to do their best. The first four wickets fell for two runs (both byes), and the fielders jubilant; but Stewart and Davies got together and completely collared the bowling.

When the score stood at 50, Stewart was caught, having made 25 runs, including one hit for six, one four, and two threes. Carter came in next, when Davies hit a ball, and Carter tried to get a run for it; but failed to get in, in time (he said he could have done it if they hadn't made the pace so hot going up the Gully in the morning.) Emery came next, and succeeded in making 8 runs, when he was caught; the remainder retired without scoring. Davies carried out his bat with 28 runs, including one hit for six, the total score of the PRAHRANITES being 75; the game resulting in a victory for "ours" by 37 runs.

An adjournment was then made to the hotel for tea, and after three cheers had been given for the host and hostess (Mr. and Mrs. Charman), a start was made home ward, and all reached Prahran safely a little after half past nine, having had beautiful weather all day, and all declared that they had enjoyed the day's outing immensely.

**23/2/1881** **SBMJ** SCORESBY vs NARRE WARREN: A match between the above two clubs took place on the Narre Warren ground on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> instant (12/2/1881) and resulted in a victory for the local team with five wickets to spare. After strenuous efforts on the part of several of the more prominent members of the SCORESBY CLUB to get an eleven together, only seven turned up so SCORESBY played four men short. **Refer Scorebook.**

**2/3/1881** **SBMJ** An Old Buffers match was played (Poss. 19/2 or 26/2/1881) between FITZROY and FERNTREE GULLY on "Carpet" lent by the DANDENONG CRICKET CLUB. **NOTE: This carpet was referred to as "Brussels Carpet", the forerunner to "Coir Matting".**

**9/3/1881** **SBMJ** NARRE WARREN vs SCORESBY: The above clubs played for the second time during the season at Scoresby on Saturday last (5/3/1881). A very pleasant afternoon was spent, and both teams seemed thoroughly to enjoy themselves. The match was entirely free from any of the petty disputes so common in country matches. The SCORESBYITES won very easily. **Refer Scorebook.**

**23/3/1881** **SBMJ** FITZROY CRICKET CLUB to play a FERNTREE GULLY team next week (26/3/1881) at Ferntree Gully
