HOW, WHEN & WHERE IT PROBABLY ALL BEGAN

27/9/1882 DA A meeting of the **FERN TREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB** was held at the Hunting Tower Hotel on the 20th. Mr. J. McComb in the chair when the following members were elected **Office Bearers for the coming season: H.P. Hayward Esq. (President), J. McComb (Vice President), Thomas Jones (Hon. Treasurer), F.J. (Frederick John) Charman (Hon. Secretary).** The following members were appointed as **Match Committee: Thomas Jones, S. Ferguson and F.J. Charman**

27/9/1882 SBMJ FERN TREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB: Last Wednesday (20/9/1882) evening a meeting of cricketers took place at Charman's Hotel, Ferntree Gully, for the purposes of forming a club to represent the district. For several seasons there have been two clubs in existence, the Scoresby and the Ferntree Gully Clubs, but as each had become extinct it was thought possible to form the whole of the cricketing talent into one club, and the proposal is meeting with general approval. At the meeting Mr. McComb was voted to the Chair and in a few words stated the objective of the meeting, at the same time sketching out the course of business to be pursued.

The following Office Bearers were appointed – **President: Mr. Hayward, Vice President: Has resigned, Honorary Secretary: Mr. Charman, Match Committee: Messrs Jones, Charman and Ferguson.** The Annual Subscription was fixed at five shillings per member. It was decided to hold an entertainment in the schoolroom on the 20th inst, to celebrate the opening of the club, and Messrs **Ferguson, Williams, Pierce, Minns and Charman** were appointed a committee to carry such into effect. Practice days were fixed for Wednesdays and Saturdays. After a committee had been appointed to draw up a code of by-laws and several members had been initiated, the meeting adjourned.

27/9/1882 DA A meeting of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB was held at the Hunting Tower Hotel on the 20th. Mr. J. 25/10/1882 DA SPRINGVALE vs FERNTREE GULLY: A cricket match was played at Springvale on Saturday October 21st, 1882, between the SPRINGVALE and FERNTREE GULLY CLUBS, the former winning by seven wickets. **Refer Scorebook.**

11/11/1882 DA F.J. Charman (68* B.T. Innings) for SPRINGVALE 6/97 vs OAKLEIGH 12 (31/10/1882), F. Stevens 6/4, J. Bergin 3/6 for Springvale

8/11/1882 DA A match will take place between the DANDENONG and FERNTREE GULLY CLUBS next Saturday (11/11/1882). Play to commence at 1 o'clock.

15/11/1882 DA DANDENONG vs FERNTREE GULLY: A match took place between the above clubs on Saturday 11th, Nov 1882, resulting in a defeat of the GULLY. For DANDENONG R. Keys 23, C. Street 22*, J. Roberts 14, I. Keys 14 and W.G. Keys 12 batted well as did Munro for FERNTREE GULLY with 9. For DANDENONG J. Roberts and R. Keys did the bowling honours, the bowling being dead on resulting in a great reason as to the small scores made by the losers, the fielding was of first class description. J. Dowell distinguished himself behind the wickets. **Refer Scorebook.**

It is all very well to put the produce of the web footed birds down to Williams' throws. A great deal of dissatisfaction was expressed at the bowling of Williams of FERNTREE GULLY, in the match against DANDENONG on Saturday. It seems his delivery amounts to a genuine throw, a style which might be got over by practising straight arm bowling.

The BERWICK club is waiting for challenges from SPRINGVALE, MORNINGTON, OAKLEIGH, FERNTREE GULLY, NAR NAR GOON and other clubs – they have only played three matches and won two.

15/11/1882 SBMJ DANDENONG vs FERNTREE GULLY, A cricket match took place between the above clubs on Saturday (11/11/1882) resulting in the defeat of FERNTREE GULLY. For the losers Munro made 9. The bowling and fielding of the DANDENONG team was first class and accounts for the small scores made by the FERNTREE GULLY against the DANDENONG club. Visitors 38 to DANDENONG 118

11/11/1883 HAWB On Saturday 6th inst, a return match was played at RINGWOOD between a team from FERNTREE GULLY and the local club.

Time only allowed one innings being played. The victory resulted with the locals; the visitors batting two men short, RINGWOOD 50 defeated FERNTREE GULLY 27. Refer Scorebook. **NOTE: This article infers an earlier match had also been played against RINGWOOD this season.**

13/1/1883 **STKT** Next Thursday (18/1/1883) the PRAHRAN TRADESMEN intend having a "gala day" at Ferntree Gully. It is expected that there will be about a hundred present, and if they get fine weather, they will, without doubt, have a jolly day.

All being well, I intend going; in fact, I could not stay away from such a jolly lot of fellows as the TRADESMEN, for no matter where they go, whether it be to CORRANDERRK and get put out for 16 runs, or to any other part of the colony, they always have some splendid fun.

All the necessary arrangements have been made, so as to ensure a success. Vice-President Crook and the secretary had a journey out to the Gully last Monday to make the necessary arrangements with Host Grimwood, who has undertaken the catering.

A breakfast will be provided at Lording's Railway Hotel, Windsor, at half-past four and the wagonettes will start at 5 sharp. The roads being in good order the drive up will be very pleasant. Another breakfast will be ready as soon as the party arrives at the Gully. The time between breakfast and dinner will be devoted to "rambling" about the country, Dinner at one, and then an afternoon's sports, Tea at half past five, and then start homeward at a quarter past six. Any, who are not there, will, I am sure, lose a great treat.

1/3/1883 **HAWB** NUNAWADING (BOX HILL) vs FERNTREE GULLY; this match was played on the 17th February on the ground of the latter, resulting in an easy victory for NUNAWADING – 125 to 25

22/3/1883 **FITZ** RAINBOW vs FERNTREE GULLY on Easter Monday (26/3/1883), RAINBOW Team: Allen, Best, Craig, Knott, McIntyre, Petherbridge (2), Robinson, Smart, Stanesby and Whyte. RAINBOW to meet at Rob Roy Hotel at 3:30 am

28/3/1883 **DA** ...and from here I leave and wind my way to the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET GROUND where a match is being played between our local club and that of SPRINGVALE (24/3/1883), who had to suffer a defeat from our club, the latter making 29, the former 49. The only men from SPRINGVALE who made a stand at the wicket were J. Bergin and Walsh. Bergin being the longest in, but Walsh played more defensively.
