EASTERN DISTRICT TROPHY COMPETITION COMMENCES ITS THIRD SEASON

9/11/1900 **BHR** The MITCHAM DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB played their next match against FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB on the 10th inst. (Tomorrow)

10/11/1900 **PTEL** Prahran Independents v. FERN TREE GULLY C.C. — This match will be played at Lower Fern Tree Gully on Prince of Wales Birthday (**Monday 12th November**); Prahran's team: — Carson, Conquest, Emms, Ferrier (2), Green, Hulme (2), Hunt (S), Prior, Stewart, Stephens, and Summers. The above named are requested to catch the 9 15 a.m. from Prince's Bridge. Play starts at 11 a.m. sharp.

16/11/1900 **BHR** The MITCHAM DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB played their fourth match on the oval at Mitcham on Saturday (10/11/1900) against the visitors from FERNTREE GULLY. MITCHAM won the toss and elected to bat while Chandler and Pickett opened the bowling for the visitors. MITCHAM were all out for 118 which is a great score against the FERNTREE GULLY CLUB who everyone knows are first class cricketers. The GULLY team commenced batting with Chandler and Murch and these two were unseparated at the call of stumps; the match resulting in a draw with FERNTREE GULLY 0/88 (Chandler 42, Murch 40). It was rather hard to ask the MITCHAM XI to tackle FERNTREE GULLY so soon after Clean Sweeps cup victory, but they played like trojans, every last one of them.

23/11/1900 **HER** M.C.C. eleven play the COLLEGIANS, at the Wesley ground; MELBURNIAN at the C. of E. ground: FERNTREE GULLY, at the Gully; EAST CAULFIELD at Caulfield; and PRAHRAN MEDICALS, at Warehousemen's ground (matting wicket).

24/11/1900 **AGE** M.C.C. elevens play the COLLEGIANS at Wesley, MELBOURNIANS at C. of E. ground, PRAHRAN MEDICALS at Warehousemen's, FERNTREE GULLY at the Gully, and EAST CAULFIELD, at Caulfield, MORELAND vs FRIENDLIES, at 3, on the ground of the latter.

24/11/1900 **ARGUS** Matches for Today; M.C.C. elevens play the COLLEGIANS at Wesley, MELBOURNIANS at C. of E. ground. PRAHRAN MEDICALS at Warehousemen's, FERNTREE GULLY at the Gully, and EAST CAULFIELD, at Caulfield

27/11/1900 **AGE** MELBOURNE v. FERNTREE GULLY — Drawn match. M.C.C. 102 (Stephen 31 not out, F.H. Dodge 21, S.G. Strahan 18). Williams, Pickett and Thompson bowled well. The GULLY lost eight for 59 (A. Lording 22 not out). D. Reese took five wickets for 20 and Amies three for 25.

13/12/1900 **DA** Cricket has taken off here again at FERNTREE GULLY and nearly every vacant date is engaged.

14/12/1900 **BHR** MITCHAM CRICKET CLUB — The next match will be at the Gully on Saturday 15th (tomorrow). The Secretary wishes to draw special attention to the fact that this being the only match to be played off Mitcham ground this season, out of twenty six booked, he hopes that the members will line up at Ferntree Gully, so as not to disappoint the GULLY CLUB

21/12/1900 **BHR** MITCHAM DISTRICT CRICKET CLUB: The 8th match of the above club was played on the Ferntree Gully ground on Saturday last in the presence of a few spectators, there being a banquet on at the shire hall, and more attention was paid to tucker than cricket.

R. McClelland, who captained the MITCHAM team, lost the toss, and the GULLY batsmen, thinking they had a very soft snap, sent in the MITCHAM Bushmen to bat. D. Bowen and W. Boyle started the campaign, while Pickett and Lording took the ball. Bowen was disposed of when the score reached 11. O. Boyle filled up the gap, and the two batsmen gave the fielders a lot of leather hunting. Boyle put up 24 when he was caught from one off Lording - 2 for 56. C. Bowen followed, but only added 5 to the score when he was bowled by Pickett. D. McClelland went back for a duck. R. McClelland played a dashing game, mastering all the bowlers, knocking them all over the country, and he succeeded in getting top score with 35 (not out). W. Barelli and F. Kiker did not reach double figures 6 for 90.

L. Barelli, a twelve-year-old boy did well in securing 15 (not out) against the very fast bowling. Ranji, like D. McClelland, went down for a quack-quack, the sundries amounted to 16, and the innings closed at 8 for 134. The score was quite a surprise to the natives, who started their innings with A. Lording and Pickett at the wickets, and D. Bowen and Boyle bowling. Lording was the first to go, bowled by Boyle, 1 for 29. F. Lording had just reached 15 when Bowen scattered his stumps. Pickett, Stephens, Pennyfather, Jackson, Lording, and others were unable to do anything with Bowen and Boyle, who were bowling in great form, the innings closing for 40, MITCHAM thus winning by 2 wickets and 94 runs - a great performance.

The MITCHAMITES who went to the Gully and played so well, deserve hearty congratulations especially S. Barelli and young Walker; the club's official scorer. The next match will be at Mitcham against E.L. YENCKEN & CO's team
