

Newspaper Notes

10/9/1903 DA A meeting of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB is announced for Saturday evening at the Shire Hall. The Shire of Ferntree Gully celebrated its fourteenth anniversary last Saturday week. Cr. Thos. Dobson is the only remaining member of the original Council.

17/9/1903 DA The FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB held its **Annual Meeting** in the Shire Hall last Saturday when there was a good attendance and live interest taken in the club's affairs.

24/9/1903 DA The **Annual General Meeting** of the local CRICKET CLUB was held in the Shire Hall on Saturday evening. The club opens the season with a substantial credit balance and its record for last season shows that out of 22 matches played, 14 were won, 4 drawn and 4 lost. Increased interest is being displayed this year and there is every prospect of a strong club being formed. The following Office Bearers were elected for 1903/04 – President: Cr. Monk, Vice Presidents: Cr. McIntosh, Messrs Head, Dickinson, G. Williams, A. Lording and A.E. Selman, Mr. F.N. Stevens was again elected Honorary Secretary and Mr. E.C. Marsh the Honorary Treasurer. The Committee consists of Messrs Clark, Jackson and Simmonds and the Match Committee of Messrs Charman, Clark and Marsh.

<u>25/9/1903</u> HER A team has been formed in connection with the "NEW IDEA", and for their first match they will journey to Ferntree Gully tomorrow and play the locals. 10/3/1904 BHR The ERRATICS CRICKET CLUB journeyed to Ferntree Gully last Saturday to try conclusions with the locals, which after an enjoyable game resulted in a win for the ERRATICS CRICKET CLUB by 30 runs.

15/4/1904 HER The BOOT TRADE CRICKET ASSOCIATION plays a match against LOWER FERNTREE GULLY tomorrow. Between thirty and forty members are expected to go from the different boot factories. The team will be picked at the Gully. A train leaves Prince's Bridge at 1.35.

5/5/1904 DA Mr. Chas. Thornell, our popular young cricketer and footballer has recently been married to Miss May Martin of Corowa, NSW.
