25/11/1905 **AUST** About 50 members of "THE ARGUS TEAM" (Including wives and lady friends) journeyed to Lower Ferntree Gully last Saturday (18/11/1905) to play the IMPERIALS. The visitors won by 83 runs, the scores being "THE ARGUS" 110, IMPERIALS 27. The run getters for THE ARGUS were Mackay 43 (including 9 fours), E. Cooper following with a nicely compiled 19. Opie 15 and Gould 12 obtained their runs by good cricket. C. Eastman of "THE ARGUS" was very successful with the ball getting 4 wickets for 7 runs and Mackay secured 6 for 13. Every wicket was clean bowled. The highest scorers for the locals were Andrews 5 and Mahon 4, and the wickets were obtained by Mahon, three for 34, Thorn two for 32, Stevens three for 21 and Cox 1 for 18.

3/3/1906 **PTEL** PRAHRAN TRADESMEN v. FERNTREE GULLY; The above match was played on the Hawksburn Cricket Ground, on Wednesday afternoon last, and resulted in a victory for the latter team by 19 runs, the scores being FERNTREE GULLY 95, PRAHRAN TRADES 76. Refreshments were served during the afternoon, and in the evening the visitors were entertained at dinner, at the Mechanics Institute. There was a large attendance; ladies being well represented.
