24/11/1906 ARGUS "THE ARGUS" team played at Lower Ferntree Gully (assume Saturday 17 th November 1906) and won easily. The victors scored 161 for four wickets, the vanquished 49. For "THE ARGUS", Gould made 77, including 13 4's. Other Doubles were, Windley 35 not out, Allen 21 and Betts 20. Cooper dealt out destruction with the ball, six of the GULLY falling to him for 10 runs. He just missed the hat trick. Eastman got three for 20.

2/2/1907 WILLC The CYMS team journeyed to Ferntree Gully last Saturday to play a selected team from that district and won by 1 run. The scores were CYMS 65 (A. Mills 26, T. O'Dea 11) def FERNTREE GULLY 64 (T. O'Dea 5/12 & A Mills 3/11)
16/2/1907 MALVS On Wednesday (20/2/1907) the annual trip of the PRAHRAN TRADES to Ferntree Gully takes place, intending players or
2/3/1907 PTEL PRAHRAN TRADES vs FERNTREE GULLY; On Wednesday week last (20/2/1907) the PRAHRAN TRADES C.C. Journeyed to Ferntree Gully and engaged the local club in what provided to be an exciting and enjoyable game. Leaving Prahran at about noon they arrived, with only one stoppage, at the trysting place at 1 p.m. An adjournment was made to the cricket ground. Captain Kirkwood, with his usual luck winning the toss, sent his team into bat. Ruddell was in form, and hit out for 29, as did Manning and Kirkwood. In fact, all the team showed improved form, and the score was 106 when the innings closed.
The GULLY team just failed to win scoring 100 runs and being therefore beaten by 6. Phillips, Raphael, Manning and Rothstadt bowled well. FERNTREE GULLY afterwards entertained the visitors at a sumptuous tea, during which speeches of a felicitous nature were made by Messrs Kirkwood, Wollenden, Cackett, Rothstadt, and others. An hour's harmony contributed by Messrs Cope, Phillips, Moore, Kirkwood and others was enjoyed, and home was safely reached after a splendid days outing.
2/3/1907 BHR PRAHRAN TRADES vs FERNTREE GULLY; On Wednesday last week the PRAHRAN TRADES CC journeyed by drag to Ferntree Gully and engaged the local club in what proved to be an exciting and close game 106 to 100, in favour of the visitors

NOTE: This article also refers to the topic of Fred Stevens' longevity as an opponent of the PRAHRAN TRADESMEN indicating that he first played against them '26 years ago', which would date the first match between the two clubs in the 1880/81 season though no record has been discovered to confirm this – though given he was playing for SPRINGVALE CRICKET CLUB in 1879 the article possibly refers to his affiliation with them and not the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB.
