# Newspaper Notes

**5/10/1909** **ARGUS** R.C.C. (Probably RICHMOND CRICKET CLUB – per SPORT 24/12/1909) RAMBLERS vs FERNTREE GULLY: FERNTREE GULLY 5/125 (Carrington 43, Head 24, Pickett 14 not out); RAMBLERS 9/83 (Martin 15, F. Russell 14 not out, T. Madden 11). For FERNTREE GULLY; McMahon took 4 wickets for 22, Cox 4 for 33 and Carrington 1 for 3. For the RAMBLERS; Woods took 2 wickets for 14 runs (5 maidens), Svenson 2 for 49 and Lee 1 for 27.

**6/10/1909** **HER** The RICHMOND CLUB sent their "Ramblers" team to Ferntree Gully last Saturday to play a match against the local club. The GULLYITES scored 125 for five wickets. The principal scorers were - Carrington 43, Head 24, and Pickett 14 (not out). The RAMBLERS lost nine wickets for 83, Martin scoring 15, F. Russell 14 (not out), and T. Madden 11. For FERNTREE GULLY McMahon took 4 wickets for 22, Cox 4 for 33, and Carrington 1 for 3. For the RAMBLERS Woods took 2 for 14 (5 maidens), Svenson 2 for 49 and Lee 1 for 27

**22/10/1909** **HER** PRESTON AMATEURS played FERNTREE GULLY, at the Gully last Saturday (16/10/1909). The AMATEURS made 129, C. Greenhough contributing 37; J. Rutter 31, C. Stanlake 16 and W. Wilson 8 (not out). FERNTREE GULLY scored 92, of which Pickett contributed 25, and Treloar 19 (not out). The principal bowlers for the AMATEURS were F. Watson five for 14, D. Kerr two for 21, and J. Hedigan three for 29; for FERNTREE GULLY, F.W. Carrington six for 31, McMahon one for 39, Cox one for 21, and Town one for 5.

**22/10/1909** **OFTG** The fixture of the NOTTING HILL CRICKET CLUB details matches against FERNTREE GULLY IMPERIALS on 24/12/1909 and 11/3/1910. There are no scores known from these matches.

**24/12/1909** Date of first match against NOTTING HILL CRICKET CLUB (F.W. Carrington 101\*)

**22/1/1910** **RICHG** RICHMOND RAMBLERS strolled away from FERN TREE GULLY C.C. last Saturday. The scores were 6 for 175 to 56.

R.C.C. RAMBLERS v. FERN TREE GULLY - This match was played last Saturday, and resulted as follows:— FERN TREE GULLY all out for 56 (Lee 7 for 22, King 2 for 7), and RAMBLERS 6 for 175 (J. Gleeson 56 retired, Woods 35, Martin 23, Parkin 44 not out, and T. Madden 3 not out).

**11/3/1910** Date of second match against NOTTING HILL CRICKET CLUB

**29/7/1910** **BHR** **FERNTREE GULLY RECREATION GROUND (j.s.):**

"We want a plan," the wise men said,  
And thought and thought,  
And scratched their head  
(Which spoke of ample learning),  
"By which we may without a doubt,  
The young men's true career find out"  
(This sent their cheeks a-burning).  
"We've got a recreation ground out there  
On which the boys can dare and tear"  
(Dear me the plot increases),  
"But what we've spent and what we did  
Requires about two hundred quid"  
(And then they fell to pieces).

No wonder it sounded too good to be true. Spend £200 on the boys! Why not, are they not the hope of FERNTREE GULLY? Cr's Monk and Alan Selman are to be congratulated on knocking their heads together to formulate such a sensible scheme.

To spend money on this GROUND in dribs and drabs does no good to anyone, because the ground needs levelling before any game could be played on it, and to keep putting off the work reminds us of one of Mr. Lorimer's characters who was a terror to procrastinate.

Old Doc Hoover used to put off saying his prayers until he got into bed, and then he had to wait until he got into the right frame of mind, ultimately, he went to sleep without saying them at all, and "he was a might religious man too." This £200 is not such a terrible expense after all, as it will easily prove to be a self supporting scheme. It is not long since the Lilydale Council borrowed £1200, not £200, to provide amusement for the young people of Ringwood and Croydon, and both places are meeting their liabilities.

It is some years since Cr. Alan Selman moved in the matter to purchase this RECREATION GROUND, and up to the present it has neither been of use nor ornament, but if the bank agrees to allow an overdraft of £200, a change will soon come over the scene, and Ferntree Gully will have a properly equipped RECREATION GROUND for tennis, football, cricket, &c and later on it is intended to add a swimming bath. The levelling of the ground will kill two birds with one stone – the soil for filling will excavate the baths, and ratepayers will have a proper RECREATION GROUND bought with their own money.

It was pleasing to see this scheme so well supported. Every Councillor was heartily in accord, and when the small matter with the bank is fixed up the work will be proceeded with. As a first step Cr. Alan Selman moved, seconded by Cr. Monk, that ornamental trees be at once planted all round the ground. This was carried and the carrying out of the work was left in the hands of the Shire President and riding members.

**2/9/1910** **BHR** The **Annual Meeting** of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB was held in the Shire Hall on Saturday August 20<sup>th</sup> when the following Office Bearers were elected... **President: Cr. H. Monk, Captain: W. Cox, Vice-Captain: Mr. F. Nelson, Match Committee: Mr. J. McMahon, W. Cox and F. Carrington, General Committee: Messrs F. Nelson, W. Foster, W. Cox, L. Schultz and J. McMahon, joint Honorary Secretary's: Mr. A. Pickett, F.W. Carrington, Honorary Treasurer: Mr. F.W. Carrington.** It was decided if 'Rules of Competition' permit to enter into the "Reporter Association" and Messrs F. Nelson and H. Pickett were appointed Delegates of the club to attend the meeting of the Association. A prosperous season is looked forward to. Last Seasons averages were...
