**15/9/1911** **BHR** The Council and Officers' match with the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB was fixed for September 30.

**15/9/1911** **HER** The **Annual Meeting** of the FERNTREE GULLY club was held last week, when the following office-bearers were elected for the coming season: — **President, Cr. H. Monk; captain, Mr. F. Carrington; vice-captain, Mr. J. McMahon, Joint hon. secretaries, Messrs. A. Pickett and F. Carrington.** A trophy presented by Mr. Knight for the most improved player last season was won by H. Pickett. F. Carrington won both the batting and bowling averages, but under a rule providing that any one player shall only receive one trophy, the awards were made as follows: - Batting, Carrington; bowling, A. Pickett. The club has several vacant dates for the coming season. Correspondents should communicate with Mr. A. Pickett, Ferntree Gully.

**22/9/1911** **BHR** The **Annual Meeting** of the FERNTREE GULLY CRICKET CLUB was held on Wednesday, 6<sup>th</sup> September when the following Office Bearers were elected for the coming 1911/12 season, **President: Cr. Charman and H. Pickett, Hon. Secretary: A. Pickett, Hon. Treasurer: F.W. Carrington.** The club expects the season to open on 30<sup>th</sup> September. Selman, Chandler and Clements were present and most of the officers and day men were also present and played. **Cr. Monk captained the Shire Team** while the Club side was captained by **its appointed leader for the coming season, F.W. Carrington.** Scores follow...

**5/1/1912** **BHR** The EMERALD CRICKET CLUB visited Ferntree Gully last Saturday (31/12) and were defeated by the locals. Both teams played with only 9 men, and the scores were FERNTREE GULLY 154 (F. Carrington 66\*, A. Charman 31, J. McMahon 21, W. Cox 11) defeated EMERALD 68 (F. Carrington 4 wickets, W. Cox, A. Pickett and A. Charman 1 each). Next Saturday RICHMOND ANA play the GULLY.

**5/1/1912** **HER** RICHMOND A.N.A. RAMBLERS play FERNTREE GULLY to-morrow. A.N.A. members are re-quested to meet on the platform, Flinders street station, in time to catch the 1.35 train. Book to Lower Ferntree Gully station, where conveyances will drive players to the ground. Tea will be provided

**6/1/1912** **RICHA** This afternoon the A.N.A. play FERNTREE GULLY. Players are requested to catch the 1.35 p.m. train express to Box Hill

**13/1/1912** **RICHA** RICHMOND A.N.A. RAMBLERS; Last Saturday the above team journeyed to Lower Ferntree Gully, and played a match, which resulted slightly in favour of the GULLY team, who batted first and put up 139 for 9 wickets, Cox 36, McMahon 30, Carrington 28 and Nelson 28 were top scorers, Twose 3 for 24, Barry 3 for 36 and Roy Chitty 2 for 14 doing the bowling.

The fielding of some of the A.N.A. players was very bad and accounted for the locals making such a score. W. Ley (Wicket keeping) did splendidly, only 4 byes being run. In the field Syd Gregory (who was Captain) set his men a good example, which, I am sorry to say was not followed.

A.N.A. then batted and compiled 108 for 9 wickets lost; Herb McIntosh 36, W. Barry 22, Jack Twose 12 doing the best. Pickett 3 for 25, Carrington 2 for 11, and Sadlier 2 for 11 were the best bowlers for the GULLY. After the match tea was served in the Club Hotel, opposite the Ground (s/be Middle Hotel!), which was very much enjoyed. A start was then made for the station and the 8.28 train for Melbourne caught, after a very pleasant day's outing.
