**3/10/1914** **OFTG** **SOCIAL** NOTTING HILL v. FERNTREE GULLY: The NOTTING HILL CRICKET CLUB will play their first match of the season this afternoon on the ground of the latter. Members are requested to roll up in force. Conveyance will leave Beveridge's Store at 2 sharp.

**10/10/1914** **OFTG** **SOCIAL** NOTTING HILL v. FERNTREE GULLY: This match was played at Ferntree Gully on Saturday last (3/10/1914) and resulted in a win for the visitors by 27 runs.

**NOTE:** Given Ferntree Gully were also recorded as playing Blackburn in the Reporter DCA at the Ferntree Gully Recreation Reserve (See below), this suggest that the club was fielding a second team playing Social or Arranged matches and was in all likelihood still using either the "Middle Hotel" or "Club Hotel" playing field for these additional matches.
