NOTES:

- After many years of research, the 1st Innings of the match between Ferntree Gully and Wantirna was located (May 2009) and it makes for great reading – George McRae took 9/19 in the Wantirna 1st Innings score of 35 to go with his 10/11 in their 2nd Innings of 38, giving him match figures of 19/30; easily the best bowling performance in a match in the history of the Ferntree Gully Cricket Club.

Further research across State records indicates that this performance may be the best Match figures in Victorian suburban 1st XI cricket history.

- After this match which Ferntree Gully won on 1st Innings, W.H. (Bill) Armstrong (Capt.) having top scored with 74* in a match winning effort, unfortunately died as a result of heart failure later that evening (3/3/1923)

7/3/1923 ARGUS After playing cricket on Saturday afternoon (3/3/1923), Mr. W.H. Armstrong, of the Scoresby State School, complained of not feeling well. On arrival at home, he collapsed and died suddenly. Mr. Armstrong was captain of the local cricket club and took a prominent part in matters affecting the progress of the district. He leaves a widow and four children. ***On the day of Bill's passing temperatures reached as high as 43 degrees and given that he batted through the innings for 74 not out this may have contributed to his death.***

9/3/1923 LILEX RDCA Vice President Mr. Breaden reported the distressing and sad news that all had heard on commencing the meeting. The news being that Ferntree Gully Cricket Club Captain W. Armstrong had died suddenly after last week's game. The circumstances surrounding his death were of a painful nature. On Saturday 3rd March he had played a great game for his team, having top scored with 74 runs and leading his Club to a victory over Ringwood Churches, but on returning home suddenly took ill and died later that night.

Mr. Armstrong was one of the best sportsmen in the district and had done a lot to make cricket the interesting game that it was in the locality in which he resided. Mr. Breaden moved a motion to send a letter of condolence on behalf of the Association and both the President and Secretary confirmed this would be accepted and put into action with haste to ensure the Association's wishes were conveyed to Mrs. Armstrong.
