1. Ferntree Gully was successful with a Protest and the match result was overturned, after A.E. Chandler substituted for his son G. Chandler and was then actively involved in the outcome of the match by batting and wicket keeping in Bayswater's second innings. A dispute arose between Chandler and Ern Tew as to the acceptance of his substitution, but it appears that the Delegates determined that the 12th player was a breach of RDCA Rules and upheld the protest. A ballot was held to decide the protest on the motion of J. Wilkins (East Ringwood) and the votes went 13 to 7 for Ferntree Gully

2. The Semi Finals were contested between 1st from the A Section vs 2nd from the B Section and 2nd from the A Section (Ferntree Gully) vs 1st from the B Section (Mooroolbark)
