BATTED THROUGH THE INNINGS

Some Matches/Innings end with an opening batsman not out as the team bats all day, and its innings is compulsorily closed. Technically, if he is the 10th dismissal, he has batted through the Innings also. In recording this achievement at an international cricket level, normally these examples are <u>NOT</u> recorded as Batting through an innings.

For consistency with this standard, the table below represents performances at the FTGCC where an opening batsman batted the entire innings and remained **NOT OUT** at the fall of his teams 10th and final wicket i.e. the batsman opened the batting and remained **NOT OUT** when all the other ten batsmen in the team were dismissed.
